GENERAL COMMENTS...

- **TRANSITION DEFENSE**: We only gave up two points against Rivet and five against Shoals great job this was our best weekend of transition defense all season

TRANSITION OFFENSE

- We need to do a better job of getting wide and passing ahead especially off of turnovers
- Any opportunity that we have to pass ahead we need to do it especially against Day we need to run Huppman up and down the floor and force them to use their bench and time-outs they are only five deep.

- POST ENTRIES

- Our passing and sealing was horrendous at best. We must do a better job of entering the ball to to our post guys this weekend
- **OBUs** we have to be sharper on our cuts and execution on OBUs we need to get a couple of cheap baskets off of these each game and we didn't do a very good job especially on Friday night.
